WHAT IS A FRIEND BANK



A friend bank is a special event that guides supporters through the process of identifying their "friend circle" and supports them in reaching out to share information on a candidate, election, and issue. A friend bank is a wonderful opportunity for supporters to get to know each other, learn about candidates and issues and share that information with their circle of contacts.

WHY FRIEND BANK



The most powerful way to make an impact is to have personal conversations with friends and family.

Conversations with trusted family, co-workers and friends is proven to have the most impact of any type of voter contact. This is also a time to recruit volunteers and create a sense of community among supporters.

STEPS TO HOSTING A FRIEND BANK



- 1. Write list of invitees, set a recruitment goal for yourself.
- 2. Set a date and time, create your event on Mobilize, on a virtual platform or reserve meeting space.
- 3. Send personal invites via email, text and post on all your social media accounts and ask guests to invite others.
- 4. Follow-up and confirm prior to the event.

AGENDA



- 1. Greet and have attendees introduce themselves.
- 2. Tell your story, stress why this election is so important.
- 3. Share videos, pictures, websites.
- 4. Walk attendees through creating a list of contacts, share sample scripts and texts.
- 5. Take action, have attendees send messages or make calls while in the friend bank.
- 6. Set goals for follow-up with their contacts (24-hours, weekly, day of election.
- 7. Ask attendees to host their own friend bank.
